LAST MONDAY: Senator Vicki Schmidt represents the 20th District located in Southwest Topeka. Elected in 2004 she now serves on a number of committees including Vice Chair of the Rules and Regulations committee, Vice Chair of the Health and Welfare committee, the Ways and Means committee, the Transportation committee and a number of other committees. Last year over 900 bills were introduced in the Senate but only a small number were actually acted on and the Governor received and signed about 200. The State of Kansas will spend about \$12 Billion this next fiscal year. Some \$5.6 Billion will come from the State general fund and the rest from various sources. 65% will go to Education, only 4% to Government and Kansas Department of Transportation will only receive about .1% of the spending.
