Savings can be up to 75% off -locally. Amy explained how to get the Free ID card at a local pharmacy or on line at www.kansasdrugcard.com. Although it says "Kansas" in the web site title, these discount prescription drug cards can be used nationwide in a network of over 50,000 pharmacies including 176 recognized national chains. Dillions, Walgreens and KMart Pharmacies are preferred in the local area. The card can be used in place of another program you may have if it gets you the prescription at a lower cost.
