LAST MONDAY: Jefferey Gustin with the Royal Valley School District talked about the school district bus policy. Drivers must meet both local and state requirements including Class A,B, or C Commercial Drivers License, physical exams every 2 years, drug and alcohol testing, random drug testing, defensive driving classes, eight hours first aid and CPR, hazardous waste training, background checks, 15 to 20 hours of driving with a trainer before soloing on a school route.
