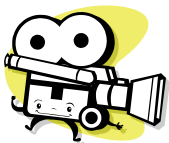
LAST WEEK:

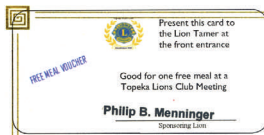
