

The Kansas Lions News for December 2012, reported that the Governors approved the redistricting plan for the Kansas Lions.


#### At a glance:

- MD-17 would go from five sub districts (L, I, O, N, S) to three (K, A, N).
- The new districts would effectively be western Kansas, northwestern Kansas and southeastern Kansas.
- The change would take affect in July 2014 if all the approvals are made.
